Liam Holman has been putting his artistic talents to good use by painting the backdrops for the Christmas pantomime at the Lifeworx café.










Thousands of runners took to the streets of Liverpool for the annual charity Santa dash, including Sara Matamalas.









A Traynor Christmas





Our roving reporter James Claxton attended the light switch on in Liverpool and Cheshire Oaks




























